Request #1: REACH Act (House and Senate)

For current members of Congress:

Hello! I am _____, a RESULTS volunteer from _____. One of the things I am really passionate about is maternal and child health. Thanks to US leadership, the number of kids who die each year before the age of five has been cut by in half since 1990. But there are still 5.9 million kids a year dying of mostly preventable and treatable causes before their 5th birthday. The bipartisan Reach Act would enact key reforms that increase the effectiveness and impact of the U.S. government's efforts to end preventable child and maternal deaths globally. Will you cosponsor the REACH Act and Ask leadership to pass the bill this year?

Request #2: The Global Fund

For new candidates for Congress:

My name is _____ and I am a RESULTS volunteer from _____. The U.S. partnership with the Global Fund to fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria has a proven track record of success, saving approximately 22 million lives.
